You can support whichever cause is closest to your heart at our hospitals – from cancer, childhood illness to stroke, neonatal equipment to dementia, you can be sure your donation will be used to help patients in your chosen area.

- **£15** could fund three pairs of slippers for vulnerable patients
- **£60** could fund activity boxes for our older persons wards

The N&N Hospitals Charity raises money to support our patients, families and staff at Norfolk and Norwich University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, which includes the N&N Hospital, the Jenny Lind Children's Hospital and Cromer Hospital.

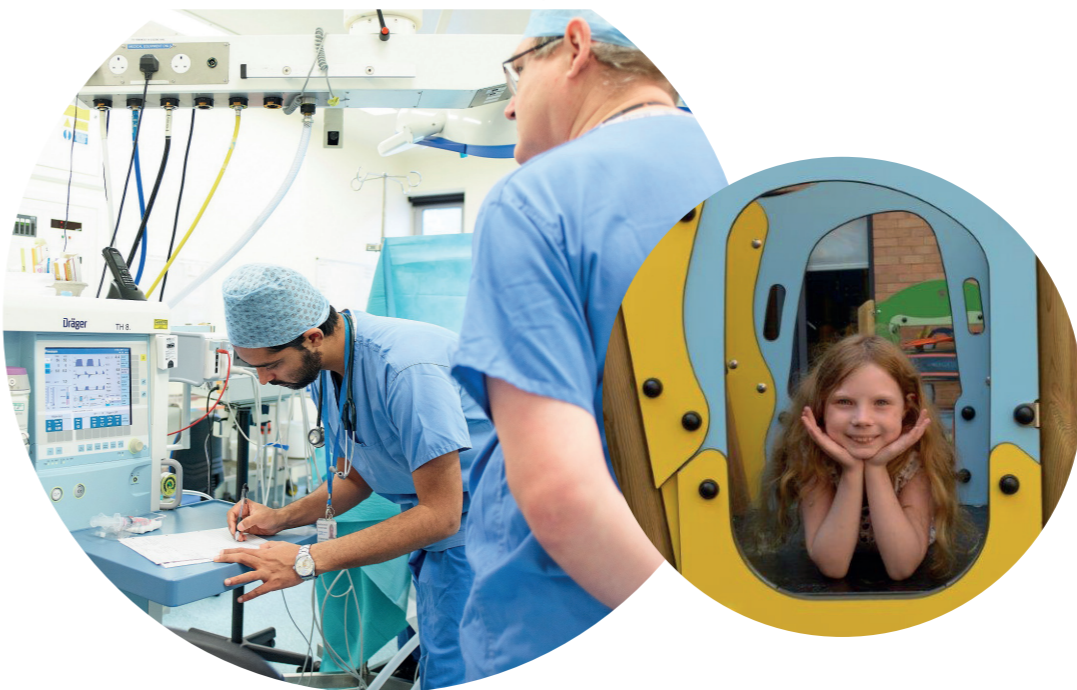

Specialist medical equipment

Thanks to your donations, we have purchased specialist medical equipment, such as:

- a £170,000 Confocal Microscope to help dermatologists view detailed images of the upper layers of skin allowing cancer to be diagnosed without the need for a skin sample
- £8,000 for a cystoscopy digital processing unit for urologists to diagnose bladder abnormalities which means the patient usually only requires local anaesthesia
- £26,000 to purchase a specialist legacy spinal turning bed for the treatment of complex trauma, including multiple injuries, spinal, and spinal cord injuries and acute medical conditions. Patients who were previously considered to be 'not for turning' can now be turned safely and comfortably - improving care without compromising their condition.



Staff development programmes

We fund staff development to help enable our staff to be the best that they can be and provide excellent patient care.



Our Jenny Lind Children's Hospital is the second oldest children's hospital in England after Great Ormond Street Hospital. More than 45,000 children are treated here each year in its various departments which equates to 123 children passing through its doors each day.

Here are some examples of what your donations could help provide:

- £500 for a baby doppler
- £700 for a glide-away bed for parents to sleep next to their child
- £30,000 Simjunior (a realistic, full-body simulator for paediatric emergencies)

Enhanced environments and facilities

Your donations are helping to enhance environments and facilities, including:

- £800,000 for a new brachytherapy unit to treat cancer patients
- £382,000 towards two new, state-of-the-art integrated theatres which will benefit patients undergoing bowel, oesophageal, gastric and gynaecological surgical procedures
- £15,000 for a new memory day room for our Older Persons Wards
- £25,000 for a new assessment unit for pregnant women
